THIS INFORMATION IS REPRINTED HERE TO REMIND YOU OF THE GUIDELINES SET FORTH BY THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA AND THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT.

Please note that we are monitored by the Los Angeles County Office of Education. If they find that we are not in compliance, our After School Education and Safety Program will be cancelled.

Given the above, please comply with the regulations.

1. Parent and guardians must leave their child(ren) at school from Monday through Thursday from 3:00 to 6:00. Parents may pick their child up early on Fridays only. Friday participation is optional.
2. If parents DO NOT leave their child(ren) daily until 6:00, children are not eligible for the program. If you have to pick up your child before 5:15, you must fill out an Early Release Form and you will pay a five dollar fee. If you have a doctor's note you do not have to pay the \$5.00 fee.
3. Only students who participate in the After School Program for four days per week will be able to participate in sports, clubs and student council.
4. Parents agreed to pay one dollar for every minute after 6:00. If a child were to be left at school past 6:30, parents agreed to pay \$30.00. Children left behind after 6:30 will be taken to Inglewood Police Department.
5. Parents agreed that my child will: Obey all adults.
 - Bring homework, a book, and something quiet to do.
 - Have a positive attitude.
 - Mind all school rules.
 - Not leave school grounds without being signed out.
 - Not have more than one discipline referral.
6. I understand that, a parent/guardian or other adult authorized by the parent or guardian, must walk onto the school grounds and sign the child out.
7. Failure to sign your child out means that your child may no longer participate in our after school program.
8. Adults sent to pick up your child must be listed on the yellow Transportation Card.
9. Persons who pick up your child after school must be at least 18 years of age, and they must be listed on the yellow Transportation Card.
10. We have a "zero tolerance" policy which means once the student, or parent breaks the after school rules, the student is out of the program.

PLEASE EXPLAIN these policies to YOUR child to make sure that YOU AND YOUR CHILD follow all the rules. FURTHER if your child chooses not to obey the above stated policies, you may not leave your child after 3:15—without exception. If you do not pick up your child by 3:15 he or she will walk home or take the bus. Finally, your child may not loiter on the streets and sidewalks around the school. If you allow your child to loiter in an unsafe environment, this is child endangerment due to the robberies, car accidents, and shootings that have occurred in the vicinity of Van Ness and Manchester intersection.
